

Early Childhood Consultation Partnership® (ECCP®)

Family Child Care Program Service

The Early Childhood Consultation Partnership[®] (ECCP[®]) is a state funded program that helps to improve the social and emotional skills of children from birth to age five. There is no cost to the Family Child Care Program or families. This is a <u>voluntary program</u>, so programs and families only receive this service if they would like to.

Masters level ECCP[®] Consultants partner with Family Child Care Program Owners to decide which socialemotional strategies to use in their program. Common reasons to call ECCP[®] include things like supporting children with challenging behaviors, creating routines or improving transitions. This strengths-based service focuses on helping the program staff, so they can best support the program's needs. ECCP[®] is best when used early, before more challenging behaviors happen.

What is ECCP® Consultation? ECCP® Consultation focuses on relationship building, problem-solving, and personal growth as we work to support young children together.
