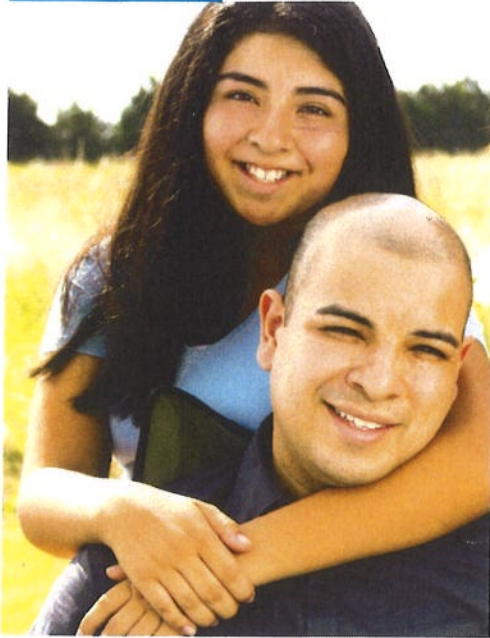

Fatherhood Engagement Services



When fathers are involved in their children's lives, everyone benefits. The Village's Fatherhood Engagement Services program is here to support fathers in strengthening their parenting skills and involvement.

Fatherhood Engagement Services works to help strengthen father-child bonds and enhance the level of involvement of fathers in their DCF case planning, provision of services and positive parenting. Through intensive outreach, case management services and group programming, program staff help fathers learn skills and characteristics to be a positive, reliable figure in their children's lives.

FES is a free program available in English and Spanish to in-home and out-of-home fathers. Available services include:

- Parenting Education – 24/7 Dad©: This group-based curriculum consists of twelve 2-hour sessions and focuses on teaching men the characteristics they need to be good fathers 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
- Individual case management and linkage to services to help each father through his specific circumstances and reach his goals
